

Do-it-yourself Seed Envelops

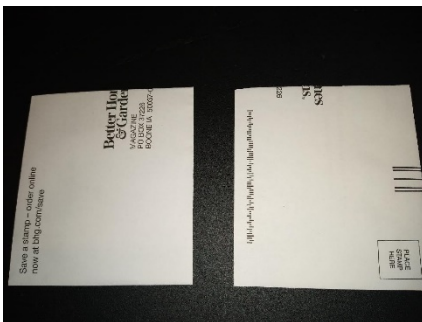
Use recycled “donation” envelopes or brand new ones....

Please try and keep the final envelop size about that of a regular seed packet for easy viewing/storage in a mushroom container.

1. Using a glue stick, put glue on the sides as well as the angled parts (“V”) of the flap. This is to insure that the envelop flap is secured so that the seeds to not escape from the sides. Note: Donation envelops do not stay glued shut with glue provided so additional glue is needed.



2. Press down and secure flap.
3. Fold envelop in half.



4. Cut along fold.

5. Fill in year/plant name on label

- Highlight annual or perennial
- Highlight Full Sun or Part Sun or Shade
- Fill in “Other info”

6. Run off “real” labels and attach to envelops or cut up printed labels and glue/tape to envelop.
7. Add seeds to envelop.
8. Fold over open side of envelop and secure with tape.

or

9. Fold over open side 2x and staple shut.
